Dear Parents or Guardian,

Your child will be visiting the Ruhkala Learning Commons soon and will have an opportunity to check out a book(s). A positive experience with the library and books is an important part of your child's progress toward becoming a fluent reader and a life-long learner. I'm looking forward to providing your child with enjoyable and information-filled books and an enriching library program.

Your child will learn how to select and use library materials. We will discuss responsible use of these materials and the correct treatment of books.

In order to make this a successful and enjoyable experience, you can help your child in the following ways:

* Encourage your child to share the books with you. Read together! Older students also enjoy being read to or even reading to you. It is a wonderful family activity.

* Check the schedule below for your child's scheduled library day. Look forward to this special weekly event.

* Remind your child to return or renew books on time on their library day. Books are checked out for **two weeks** at a time and **do not** allow students with overdue books to check out new materials. K and 1* grade students may check out one book at a time, and 2nd through 6th may check out two at a time.

* Have a special place to keep library books. Keep them away from possible damage by moisture, young children, food or pets! I suggest a large zip baggie be kept in their back pack to transport the book. This will keep it safe from water bottles, lunches and loose pens or crayons. We loose a few every year!

* If a book is accidentally damaged, **please do not attempt to repair it yourself**. Return it to the library and advise the librarian of the damage so it can be repaired, if possible.

Please be aware that district policy states the current replacement cost for books that are lost or damaged beyond reasonable repair will be charged to you and your child will lose check out privileges until payment is received.

Lastly, <u>library volunteers are needed</u>. Please consider volunteering at the library. You can even help during your child's weekly scheduled library time! Also, the Book Fair will be coming and volunteers are needed for this fun event also. There is no need for any experience to come and join us. Your help is always greatly appreciated. Contact the library for more information or email me at <u>nwilson@rocklinusd.org</u>. The Book Fair is the *only* revenue generating activity the library does and the way funds are earned to purchase new books for our library. Without enough parent help, we will not be able to have a book fair thus not be able to purchase all the new titles your children are so excited about.

Thank you for your cooperation and assistance. I know that you and your child will both enjoy what our library has to offer.


