Dear RUSD Families,

Rocklin Unified School District has enhanced the use of our existing Student Information System (Aeries) by enabling the use of online Parent and Student “portal accounts”, which includes on-line registration and completion of many of the forms for the first day of school.

Aeries Portal/on-line registration accounts will compliment our continued efforts to improve school-to-home communication by providing parents and students online and timely access to information about attendance, report cards, and more.

One goal is to use this system to significantly reduce paperwork by maintaining emergency contact information online and making the annual Student Data Confirmation back-to-school/1st day packet process more convenient and efficient for parents!

Please do now:

Create your account now to access 2016-17 attendance and report records. Visit the RUSD website at: <http://www.rocklinusd.org/>. Click on the “Parent” section. Go to “Aeries (Student Information System). Here you will find step-by-step instructions on how to create your Aeries Parent Portal account using the (3) pieces of information (telephone number, verification code and student identification number) unique to your student provided to you by your school.

Coming in August: Since you will already have created your portal account, we hope you will find it more convenient to complete the back-to-school/1st day packet for your child. Look for more information in August.
