### Ruhkala Elementary School Halloween Costume & Activity Information

- Some classes may be having parties on 10/31/17. However, not every classroom has a party on this specific day. Please check with the teacher before assuming there is a party.
- On Tuesday, October 31st, students may wear costumes to school. Your children are not expected or required to wear a costume. Normal school activities are planned for this day. Therefore, the following guidelines are necessary to ensure a pleasurable and safe day for both the students and staff:
  - Emblems, words, or pictures on clothing and makeup should be appropriate to the educational atmosphere for students.
  - Costumes depicting excessive violence, fear or gore (i.e., Freddie Kruger, Scream Masks, blood, and victims, etc.) are not appropriate.
  - Costumes must be easily taken off & on for quick bathroom use, especially in Grades K-3. 4.
  - Students should come to school already dressed in their costume.
     Time will not be taken out of the instructional day to dress or undress.
  - If you are concerned that a costume might be damaged, it should not be worn to school.
  - Accessories (swords, shields, bags, etc.) that depict weapons, have sharp points, or may distract in class must be left at home.
  - The length of the costume should not obstruct the ability to participate in P.E., recess, or school activities.
  - Please direct your children to NOT share or try on any headgear/masks with other students (no lice!)
  - o If in doubt, please do not wear it!




