Welcome back,

The Ruhkala Library is now open for the school year. The library is a very exciting weekly event that the students truly love. To ensure they get the most out of it, here are a few things that you and your students need to know as we go forward with our school year.

- Books are checked out for 2 weeks at a time. Please make sure books are returned on time and do not become overdue. They may be renewed if student is not quite finished. Students who do not return their books are not allowed to check out until all books are returned our their account is cleared.
- Kindergarten and first graders are allowed to check out 1 book at a time. Second through sixth grade may check out 2 books at a time.
- Help your student find a special place to keep their library books. This will ensure the books stay in clean and damage free condition. It also helps students know where their books are located when it's library day.
- Keep books away from ALL food, liquids, younger children (who many not understand how to care for library books), dirty hands and pets. If book should incur damage, please let the librarian know. Please do not try to repair it yourself. We all understand that accidents happen and many times damage can be repaired with the right tools. But if not, you are responsible for the price of a replacement book. Please do not try to replace it on your own, we purchase our books from suppliers that sell library quality books.
- If damage is found once a book is checked out, please have your student notify their teacher or the librarian. Do not try to repair it at home. This includes taping pages if there is a tear.
- We are always looking for volunteers to help in the library or at Book Fair. If you
