Copy of School Messenger sent out from Rocklin Unified District Office on 2/27/19:

Rocklin Unified School District is committed to student and staff safety. We implement a variety of protocols in preparation for a variety of emergency situations. Each and every year, we review our safety plans and determine areas for improvement. With changes in first responder training, we identified the need to have a comprehensive plan for active violence response. Over the past 14 months, we have worked cooperatively with local law enforcement and fire to create a multi-year plan to address this need.

To prepare for an active violence situation, RUSD is implementing the Run, Hide, Fight protocol. Staff will train students in this protocol between now and March 8th. Below you will find the presentation that will be shared with your children. There are three presentations based on grade level. You will also find a few links for parents to help you navigate the conversations and follow-up discussions at home.

Thank you so much to those of you that were able to come out and give us feedback and share your concerns with us during our Parent Night on January 10th. We used this feedback to improve the student training and also brought it to District Safety Committee for review. The committee, which includes first responders, parents, administrators, teachers, and site staff, provided additional feedback that were incorporated into the final program.

Why Run, Hide, Fight?

The United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, California Office Of Emergency Services, and local law enforcement agencies recommend the Run, Hide, Fight protocol in response to an active shooter situation.
