

Transitional Kindergarten Registration 2020-21

Parents, guardians, and preschool providers:

You are invited to attend a Transitional Kindergarten (TK) Information Meeting at the RUSD District Office to learn more about the registration timeline and procedures for enrolling your child in the Transitional Kindergarten program for the 2020-21 school year. An overview will be presented on how this program will successfully start your child's educational experience and meet your child's needs. Please join us to find out about the high-quality program awaiting your child!

Requirements for entering TK for the 2020-21 school year:

- ◆ Child's birth date must be between September 2, 2015 and December 2, 2015 to attend TK per *Education Code* Section 48000(c).
- ◆ Per *Education Code* Section 48002, provide proof of child's age (for example, a certified copy of a birth certificate, a statement by the local registrar or county recorder certifying the date of birth, a duly attested baptism certificate, passport; or, when none of the foregoing is obtainable, an affidavit of the parent, guardian, or custodian of the minor ******).
- ◆ Provide proof of residence (for example, current utility bill or notarized escrow papers).
- ◆ California law, *Education Code* Section 48216, requires that each child entering school for the first time present evidence of being fully immunized against Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTP); Polio; Hepatitis B; Mumps, Measles and Rubella (MMR); Chicken Pox (Varicella), and Haemophilus Influenza Type B. **No child will be permitted to attend school in the Rocklin Unified School District unless a documented, up-to-date immunization record of required immunizations is submitted to the school.**
- ◆ California law, *Education Code* Section 49452.8(a), requires that your child have an oral health assessment by May 31 of his/her first year in public school.
- ◆ The District also recommends that each entering student have a physical examination.

****** The "Proof of Age Affidavit" form can be obtained from the school site or from the RUSD District Office during regular office hours (7:30-4:30).

Online registration for the 2020-21 school year will be available on the RUSD website, www.rocklinusd.org beginning January 14, 2020. Registration information for Transitional Kindergarten will also be available at the Information Meeting on January 21 and at the Rocklin Unified School District Office beginning January 22. Completed forms may be turned in at the January 21 meeting. **If unable to attend the Information Meeting, please return completed packet to the Rocklin Unified School District Office beginning Wednesday, January 22.**

Requirements for entering Kindergarten for the 2020-21 school year:

- ◆ Child must be 5 years old by September 1, 2020 to attend regular Kindergarten per Education Code 48000.
- ◆ Per *Education Code* Section 48002, provide proof of child's age (for example, a certified copy of a birth certificate, a statement by the local registrar or county recorder certifying the date of birth, a duly attested baptism certificate, passport; or, when none of the foregoing is obtainable, an affidavit of the parent, guardian, or custodian of the minor ******).
- ◆ Provide proof of residence (for example, current utility bill or notarized escrow papers).
- ◆ California law, *Education Code* Section 48216, requires that each child entering school for the first time present evidence of being fully immunized against Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTP); Polio; Hepatitis B; Mumps, Measles and Rubella (MMR); Chicken Pox (Varicella), and Haemophilus Influenza Type B. **No child will be permitted to attend school in the Rocklin Unified School District unless a documented, up-to-date immunization record of required immunizations is submitted to the school.**

Online registration for the 2020-21 school year will be available on the RUSD website, www.rocklinusd.org beginning January 14, 2020. Registration information for Kindergarten will also be available at the two Information Meetings on January 28 and at school offices beginning January 29. **Completed registration forms may be turned in to your neighborhood school office beginning Wednesday, January 29.**
